



## **ADMISSION**

Admission from class Lower Nursery to Class IX & XI will start from November month for the coming academic session.

Registration Form for admission will be issued at the school counter.

Canvassing or recommendations in any form will disqualify the candidate from getting admission.

Registration / Admission Form duly filled in with two photographs (passport size) of the candidate, attested photocopy of the Birth Certificate and T.C. from the school attended last (in case of candidates seeking admission to classes II and above) will have to be submitted at the time of admission. If T.C. is not readily available, it must be produced as soon as the candidate is selected for admission together with his / her installment of tution fee. Admission will be granted strictly on the basis of the performance of the candidate at the interview (for nursery candidates) and on the basis of written admission test and interview (for seeking admission to higher classes, Transition to IX & XI). In case of lower nursery and upper nursery candidate's parents (both father and mother) should turn up for the interview before the Principal. Separate admission form and fee structure is provided for Day Scholars and Boarders (Residential).

## **UNIFORM**

#### FOR PRE-PRIMARY CLASSES

### Boys & Girls:

1) Dress: House Colour T-shirt, black track pant with house colours stripe

ii) Socks: White

iii) Shoe: Black leather shoes (Black)

#### **CLASS-I ONWARDS**

Boys: White shirt (half sleeve), white shorts (Class I-IV), trousers (V onwards), plain black shoes, white socks (without design), school tie and belt.

Girls: White shirt (half sleeve), white skirt (half sleeve), plain black shoes (Bata), white socks (without design), half blazer (Coti) for class -V onwards, school tie and belt.

#### P.T. - UNIFORM

Boys: House colour T-shirt, black track pant with house colours stripe for class-I-XII, white socks, P.T. white canvas shoes (Keds).

Girls: House colour T-shirt, black track pant with house colours stripe (for all classes), white socks, P.T. white canvas shoes (Keds).

#### WINTER UNIFORM

Lower Nursery to class III school sweater in maroon colour with school monogram for boys and girls both. Class IV and above school blazer (Maroon Colour) with school monogram for boys and girls both.

Resident students should bring accessories also from home as per the list.

## **DISCIPLINE**

Discipline is the integral part of life. Nothing can be achieved in the absence of discipline. Special code of conduct, good manners and sense of self respect and respect for others including the classmates, teachers and other coworkers. A disciplinary committee supervises day-to-day discipline inside the school. Students are required to abide by the directions and rules and regulations framed by the school in the regard. Indisciplined students may be compelled to be withdrawn from the school, if the principal considers conduct of the student detrimental to the institution.





80% attendance is a must as per school rules. During school hours no student is allowed to leave school premises without the permission of the Principal or Incharge. An absentee must produce a letter from parents / guardians explaining the cause of absence. A continued absence for 15 days without prior information is liable to get his / her name struck off from the attendance register. The leave application on medical ground must be accompanied with medical certificate at the time of rejoining the class. In case of any infectious disease, it must be clearly mentioned in the medical certificate. The student affected with or expose to such disease, must inform the school authority and he or she should complete the quarantine period before he / she rejoins the school.

## **SCHOOL HOURS**

The school academic session is from April to March.

Regular classes are not held on saturdays but students may be called for special activities or remedial classes.





## **FEES**

Besides annual session charges and other fees (whenever necessary), students have to pay regular monthly tuition fee by the fifteenth day of the current month. Fees will be variable in subsequent years. Tuition fees will be accepted at the school counter between 8.00 A.M and 2.00 P.M. from the 1st to the 10th day of every current month. Defaulters will be charged a fine of Rs. 10/- after the 10th day of the current month. Name will be struck off from the attendance register in case of nonpayment of fees for more than three months. Re-admission is possible only after the clearance of all dues. Examination fee is to be paid before the start of each examination. Admit card will be issued only after the payment of examination fee and other dues, if any.

Detailed fees structure is provided for Day Scholars and Boarders (Residential).

Fees for boarders should be paid quarterly in advance.

Fees for senior secondary section should be paid quarterly in advance

## **TEACHING STAFF IN PRE - PRIMARY CLASSES**

The school has a team of highly qualified, trained and experienced teachers selected purely on merit basis. In primary wing most of the lady teachers are convent educated and kindergarten trained. Nursery classes are conducted in a frolic manner. Special audio-visual educational aids train the kids in learning correct pronunciation and lilting tunes in rhymes and recitation methods. The kids will get our focused attention all along. Our teachers are guided by expert educationists, so that they can inculcate the true essence of knowledge amongst kids.





As we are a community of learners with the children being the most vital members, we seek utmost cooperation from the parents.

The student diary is a regular bridge of communication between the teachers and the parents. Parent Teacher Meet is convened at regular intervals for face to face dialogue and exchange of views of the cherished improvement of the wards concerned. Regular Parent-Teacher meeting gives parents a venue to discuss school programs and facilitate regular and transparent communication between parents, teachers and school administration. It also provides a forum for expression and exchange of views in the general interests of the students. This has brought about a radical change in creating a harmonious relationship between the guide at school and the caretaker at home. The response has been quite encouraging. Parents and techers are joint agents to shape the life of the child. There should be proper understanding between them in the interest of the child. The meeting between parents and teachers provide opportunities to exchange ideas and to understand the problem of the child in school and at home and find the common solution. The co operation of parents in all activities of the school is important as they are part of the school family.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

#### FIELD TRIPS:

It allows students to have real world experience, which clearly illustrates and enhances the information taught in the curriculum. Field trips give a chance to experience hands on learning while being introduced to new environments.

#### **ART & CRAFT:**

In our Art & Craft classes our students are taught a variety of skills like-Creativity, Confidence, Decision Making, Visual learning, Perseverance, Collaboration and accountability.

#### **MUSIC & DANCE:**

The music classes in our school serve as a platform for creating tiny musicians in all genres and skill levels. It enables them to learn vocals, rhythm and pitch in singing and to use instruments like keyboard, drums and guitar. It also helps to showcase their talent at various events in inter school and intra school competitions.

#### **YOGA & KARATE CLASSES:**

Yoga classes help strengthening children's growing bodies and help them to improve their flexibility, which can reduce their chance of injury. Yoga teaches discipline and reduce impulsiveness. Yoga can reduce challenging behavior in the classroom by providing a physical outlet for children to express themselves.

Karate training offers many benefits for young children like: improved physical fitness, superior mind-body coordination and self-discipline, mental strength, Determination to work towards goals, Respect for others and self.

# BOARDING DETAILS

- The school provides modern boarding facility from class III to XII for Boys.
- Boarders will be provided in dormitory type accommodation and round the clock security arrangement.
- Separate wardens and qualified supporting staff for looking after the requirements of the boarders.
- A qualified dietician to ensure nutritious food is provided to the boarders.
- Students will be provided with a table and a cupboard fitted with a locker.
- There will be an infirmary to take care of the students. In case of major illness the students
  will be shifted to a Hospital / Nursing home of repute. The parents are required to reimburse the expenditure to be incurred
  to the school authorities. Details history of his past illness and current medication, if any, to be submitted during admission.
- Adequate arrangement for sports and games.






- Special class facilities for the boarders will be provided in day time & evening time, supervised by qualified teachers for examinations & competitions.
- The Boarders will be permitted to leave the school compound only on weekends in the company of the parents or local guardians.
- During school hours no student will be allowed inside the hostel except in case of illness.
- Students have to maintain strict discipline. Any in disciplinary action will lead to expulsion, from the hostel.
